



Editor Position Open for '*The Guardian*'

In December of 2009, the Society replaced retiring newsletter editor Marcus Wallace with Dick Wallace of Little Rock, Arkansas. At that time we thought a long-term editor was being put in place to continue the long record of award-winning quarterly newsletters to keep Society members aware of what was going on with policies and programs intended for the Society to follow by the founders of Clan Wallace Society in 1966, and convene activity at Games and Festivals around the U.S. and Canada.

Several newsletters into the responsibility for producing issues each quarter, we have come to the conclusion that our editor may have taken on a responsibility that he has insufficient time to complete in a timely manner, and/or his day job and emergency services position have increased their demand on his time to such a degree that he no longer has the time necessary to assemble a newsletter every three months.

We are facing the possibility that no newsletter will be forthcoming until such time as we locate someone to take on the responsibility of massaging input from a handful of us, assembling it into page frames that make up our newsletter, and forward that newsletter to those getting it via email file-attach messages, produce a CD with the newsletter file on it and forward to our newsletter manager who prints and mails to those of our members who have asked for copies via USPS delivery.

What is required for the newsletter editor position? Familiarity with MS Word or compatible word processing software; MS Publisher or compatible publishing program; familiarity with email messaging and/or telephone contact to advise of any problems in the publication of the newsletter being assembled.

Time requirements for each quarter's newsletter will depend on the editor's familiarity with the publishing program and ability to manipulate text and pictures into a newsletter with a professional look. For a typical eight-page newsletter, assembling the text and photos may take 15-20 hours of effort with expectations of having each quarter's output ready within five weeks of each submissions deadline.
